The FSA Writing Test is administered in a 120-minute session in which students write an essay in response to a prompt. The writing will be either informational or opinion. If you or your student would like to gain familiarity with the item types and response formats your student will see on the FSA assessments, sample test questions and answer keys are available at http://www.fsassessments.org/resources/?section=4-studentsa-paper-based.
