### News from the Clinic: Hand-washing Reminder!

The cold and flu season is approaching, and frequent hand-washing is considered the single most effective way to cut down on the spread of infectious diseases. Proper and consistent hand-washing greatly reduces the risk of spreading germs. When washing hands, follow these simple steps:

- \*Wet hands with warm running water.
- \*Add soap, lather hands, between fingers, backs of hands, and under fingernails for about 20 seconds.
- \*Rinse hands.
- \*Dry with clean paper towel.
- \*Turn off water with paper towel, not your clean hands. Throw towel away.

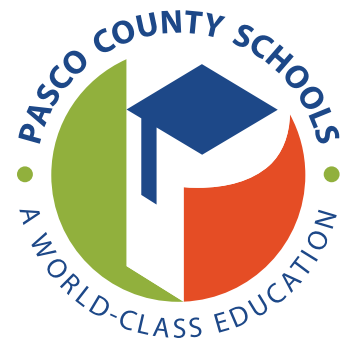
