- Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are low achieving or at most risk of falling behind.
- Title I is allocated to schools based on the percentage of student receiving free/reduced lunch.

HOW CAN YOU BE A PART OF TITLE I PARENT/COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT?

- Attend the Annual Title I Meeting, Open House, Orientation, and other programs at your school to learn more about Title I, as well as academic and behavioral expectations.
- Meet your child's teacher. Communicate with your child's teachers often to learn about your child's progress and how you can support your child and the school from home. Attend Parent-Teacher Conferences during the year.
- Create a MyStudent account to monitor your child's grades and attendance.
- Read The School Parent and Family Engagement Plan and sign the School/ Home Compact. The compact outlines expectations for the school, parent, and child. The plan helps you understand and take part in the school's effort to help reach your child's potential.
- Read the Pasco Parent Press monthly newsletter, available on the district's website: www.pascoschools.org and read the bi-monthly newsletter from the school.
- Join the PTA or SAC (School Advisory Council).

- Sign up to be a school volunteer for the 2021-2022 school year. Volunteers must reregister every year.

SCHOOL/ HOME COMPACT

- The school/home compact is an agreement to promote a partnership between the home and school, which meets the requirement of Title I Federal Guidelines to be distributed the first day of school or time of enrollment.

SCHOOL/ FAMILY COMPACT

As a Family, We Will:

- Be sure our child arrives at school between 9:20am and 9:40am everyday to assure regular attendance and we will refrain from unnecessary early dismissals.
- Follow the arrival and dismissal procedures including changes in transportation.
- Communicate regularly with our child's teacher through all means available including folder check, backpack, and scheduled conference.
- Keep the school updated with current contact information.
- Take an active part in preparing our child for school by reinforcing manners and by making sure our child is well rested, nourished, and dressed appropriately.
- Support the school in developing positive behaviors and set an example of such behavior.
- Monitor our child's nightly/weekly homework and assist our child in developing organizational skills with a communication folder, orderly backpack, and a place and time for nightly homework completion.
- Monitor your child's reading at home for 30 minutes each night.
- When visiting the school campus, during school hours, I will sign in at the front office, provide a photo ID, and always wear the visitor's badge. When leaving the school, I will check out through the main office.
- Stay informed of school happenings through a variety of ways information is communicated.
- Use the Parent Portal to stay informed on grades, absences, and state assessments (if applicable).

SCHOOL/ FAMILY COMPACT

As a Student, I Will:

- Be safe, respectful, and responsible by following school and bus (if applicable) expectations.
- Come to school each day on time and stay for the duration of the school day.
- Be prepared for school each day (get a good night sleep, complete my homework, bring my school supplies)
- Come to school with a positive attitude and ready to work hard.
- Give my parent all communication notices from the school.

SCHOOL/ FAMILY COMPACT

As a NRES Staff Member, I Will:

- Demonstrate a nurturing and positive attitude through professionalism and integrity.
