We will include a question on the survey asking parents about what they would like to see in the future. We also sent a survey at the end of the year asking parents about their interest and have incorporated those ideas in our plan for the upcoming year. At the close of next year we will send a survey out to all parents and ask them for their input.

We will enlist the help of our ELL instructional assistant to support with translation. If a family does not speak language that we have on our campus then we will use the district translation services.

One strategy that we have is to transition to the weekly communication folder. A second barrier is timing during the week. We surveyed our families to find out when they would be able to attend evening events so we prioritized those dates for our events.
